SPACE & AERONAUTICS EXPERT TAKES HOLD OF GASTONIA, NC



North Carolina entrepreneur Viresh Sitapara, a business owner and engineer from the Charlotte area, is the new owner of the PIRTEK Service & Supply Center in Gastonia, North Carolina. Located at 1101 W. Franklin Boulevard, the center features four 24/7 Mobile Service Vehicles and is staffed by a team of five.

There are three PIRTEK Service & Supply Centers in North Carolina - Gastonia, Greensboro and Charlotte.

Sitapara's background is in engineering and his career has spanned such fields as the space industry and medical technology. His interest in entrepreneurial endeavors is ongoing. He owns a successful health & beauty-related franchise in Pennsylvania, but he stays alert to new opportunities, which is how he found his way to PIRTEK.

Sitapara said he did an intensive study of various franchising opportunities and was impressed with PIRTEK on several levels. "PIRTEK is a young franchise in the United States," he said. "The business also has a technical aspect which, as an engineer, really piqued my interest. There is a lot of room for expansion. I like the business model and I was familiar with what they do."

"I came here with only 20 dollars in my pocket," Sitapara said. "I worked two full-time jobs, including a job at a gas station - 80 hours - while I was getting my master's degree. I don't sleep much so it helps."

After getting his master's degree in space and aeronautics controls, Sitapara went on to earn a Ph.D. in engineering from Kennedy Western University.

Sitapara said that purchasing an existing location has obvious advantages over a complete startup. "The business is already operating and has customers," he said. "That allows me to concentrate on other aspects of the business, instead of focusing on getting things off the ground."

One edge Sitapara has at PIRTEK is his familiarity with the kinds of industrial hoses the company replaces for its customer. During his many years working with a welding company, he was responsible for the manufacture of about 2 million hoses. "I know hoses very well," he said.

Since 2005, PIRTEK Reading Road has been serving the Cincinnati, Ohio area along with the northern tip of Kentucky. A long-time crane rental customer uses the Reading Road franchise to maintain all of its hoses and found themselves in quite a dilemma with a very limited turnaround time before its next lease.

The issue was with a 35-foot crane that needed to have a major hose replacement. Three PIRTEK Service Technicians were swung into action to ensure the job was done quickly and safely. Once the technicians arrived they inspected the crane to find the damaged hoses that needed to be replaced. In order for the technicians to replace the damaged hoses and install new ones, they were required to work up on the crane's main body where

the hydraulics are located. It wasn't an insignificant job, with nearly 30 hoses in a variety of sizes having to be removed. The three technicians were required to measure, cut, clean, crimp and install the new high pressure hoses.

The quick and efficient teamwork enabled the customers to get the crane back to work and ready to hoist its next job a day early. The customer's Service Manager stated, "We really appreciate PIRTEK's service and ability to respond 24/7. They are always available to keep us operating. A good example is this job where PIRTEK sent three vans to get us up and running as quickly as possible."

PIRTEK Team Murray'e entry into the annual Tag Heuer Pit Stop Challenge at the Indy 500 will be crewed by a rookie team of military members and first responders.

The "CK Crew" has been brought together by the Chris Kyle Frog Foundation with backing from Warner Bros. Home Entertainment, who are using the association to leverage the American Sniper Chris Kyle Commemorative Edition Blu-Ray.

The crew Members are being drawn from various key markets around the US and bring with them diverse backgrounds - from Navy SEALs who trained and served with Chris Kyle, to Police Officers, Fire Fighters and multi-disciplined first responder veterans.

At the time of writing - two CK Crew Members have been announced - David Rutherford from Boca Raton, FL is a former Navy SEAL who trained Chris Kyle. He was announced in St Petersburg Florida at the first round of the Verizon IndyCar Series, while Sonny Saghera - the Fire Captain from Heartland Fire & Rescue just outside San Diego has also joined the crew.

The next one is due to be announced in New York City the first week in May with a CK Crew Member from Texas, Chicago and Indianapolis itself set to join the crew.

They will spend a 10 day "IndyCar Boot Camp" in Indianapolis, where they will be trained in what it takes to accept the PIRTEK Team Murray Chevrolet at 60mph, change tires and get it away faster than the opposition.

The Verizon IndyCar Series has welcomed PIRTEK Team Murray and the CK Crew, with President of Competition and Operations, Jay Frye commenting:

"All of us at the Verizon IndyCar Series are proud to support the CK Crew program, which will be a great addition to the TAG Heuer Pit Stop Challenge this May," said Frye.

"Honoring members of the military is one of many traditions at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway and we're thankful to PIRTEK Team Murray, Warner Brothers and Taya Kyle for their efforts in putting this



program together."

The CK Crew Members are ready for action and believe they can adjust to the high pressure given their base training.

"The Indy 500 is an event that many people dream of attending," said Sonny Saghera. "But to (extend that and) come together in a new type of team, a new environment, learning new skills - but drawing on the training that we've all had at varying levels throughout our careers - is incredibly exciting."


David Rutherford - who is now a motivational speaker, author and podcaster is jumping out of his skin about the Challenge.

FISHING CHALLENGE ATTRACTS BIG NUMBERS

The annual PIRTEK Fishing Challenge right around Australia attracted over 7,300 entries at the end of March.

Billed as the largest single day fishing extravaganza in Australia, the Challenge offers over \$175,000 in cash and prizes, including a \$25,000 Stacer Boat and Evinrude Outboard package, including trailer.

The event raises money for two organizations - Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia and the Peter Duncan Neurosciences Research Unit at St Vincent's Hospital, Sydney - the research unit named after PIRTEK founder, Peter



Duncan that conducts research to develop treatments for chronic neurodegenerative disorders such as Multiple Sclerosis, HIV-associated Neurocognitive Disorders, Alzheimer's disease; Parkinson Disease and Stroke.

Australia is divided into several regions dependent on State or waterway system and prizes are issued for Junior and Adult competitors - as well as a chosen 'Mystery Length'. It is a catch and release system where photographs of the fish are uploaded laid out on a measurement mat. New for 2016 was an App where anglers could send entries direct from their phones.

Since its inception, the PIRTEK Fishing Challenge has raised nearly \$1 million for charity.

PIRTEK holds a business-tobusiness relationship with the Penske Transportation Group's growing portfolio in Australia.









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

Tracking India's Feline

Our travel writer and photographer recently encountered tigers in a central Indian jungle, and found their fate - thanks to poachers and increasing human populations - no different from the African lion.

he tiger has always played a part in our collective consciousness, often interpreted as a symbol of power, strength and beauty. In Hindu culture, the tiger is revered as the sacred vehicle of Durga, the warrior goddess.

And I had the opportunity to come face-to-face with this mighty animal on a recent trip through the forests of central India where a majority of them still roam.

I arrived at the Bandhavgarh National Park (BNP), in the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh, by plane from New Delhi, landing in Jabalpur and then by car to the park; a journey of 600 miles to visit the home of an animal that has existed for two million years.

Known to have evolved from the saber-toothed cat that lived 32 million vears ago, tigers have spread from their original home in China and evolved into many subspecies including the Royal Bengal Tiger of India. The BNP was the hunting preserve of the rulers of the state in the 1800s and has hosted many hunters from the British Raj; it has documented killings of over 350 cats by one particular hunter during his five-vear posting in India. At the close of the 19th century, when Rudyard Kipling penned The Jungle Book, some 50,000 to 100,000 tigers were thought to roam the Indian subcontinent.

The tiger once ranged widely across Asia, from Anatolian Turkey in the west to Kamchatka, in the

eastern coast of Russia; over the past 100 years tigers have disappeared from southwest and central Asia. According to the World Wildlife Fund (WWF), tigers inhabit less than 6% of their historic range with a 42% decline since 2006. Breeding populations of tigers are currently found in eight range states: Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nepal, Russia, and Thailand.

Since 1900, the number of tigers in the wild has shrunk from an estimated 100,000 to as few as 3,200. WWF is working toward a bold but achievable goal to double the number of tigers in the wild by 2022, the next Year of the Tiger. A 2015 news report reveals healthy population increases in all ranges in south and central India.

Strictly-managed and controlled jeep safaris are the only way one can encounter these magnificent animals in their natural habitat. My first encounter on my trip was with a mother and her three grown cubs that paced majestically through the sal tree forest, disappearing often into the high grass that grows after the monsoons.

This was the beginning of a fourday, 32-hour photographic 'hunt' for these animals. Sighting and photographing seven of them was not easy since they are primarily active in the wee hours, returning after a hunt, or during dusk before a hunt. Being solitary animals and effectively camouflaged, tracking them is one of the great joys and challenges of wildlife photography.





At 6AM on a cold morning, I was filled with excitement when I spotted a young male tiger, looking tired and hungry after an unsuccessful night of hunting. He approached my jeep from 600 feet away, oblivious to my presence and walked within a few feet marking his territory along the way.

Tigers need to kill 60-75 large prey animals per year. They are opportunistic predators, however, their diet includes birds, fish, rodents, insects, amphibians and reptiles in addition to other mammals such as primates and porcupines. Tigers can also take ungulate prey much larger than themselves, including the water buffalo, Indian bison, small elephants and on occasion even rhinos. Bandhavgarh boasts all of the above animals except the rhino and elephant which are distributed further north in Chitwan Park near the border with Nepal, another known tiger range. On my last evening, after patiently waiting near a waterhole for two hours, I was rewarded with a large male tiger emerging from the bamboo thicket

to drink water barely 15 feet away. His majesty made for some amazing pictures. I left Bandhavgarh and my lovely lodge with a heavy heart knowing that this tiger could be the victim of poachers any time.

National Geographic reports that it is rarely poor locals who are poaching the tigers - it's organized gangs.

"Tigers are part of a massive wildlife trade that's run by sophisticated international crime syndicates, the same trade that's wiping out elephants, rhinos and so many other species. It's a \$19-billion-a-year business," quotes the magazine.

These majestic cats are being slaughtered across India and the entire Southeast Asian range, mostly for their bones and magnificent pelts. Smuggled into China for use in expensive traditional tonics, tiger bones are thought to impart the animal's great energy and strength. In addition, across their entire distribution, tigers face unrelenting pressure from retaliatory killings by farmers and habitat loss. They are forced to compete for space with an ever-growing human population.

Alas, in the end, it would seem their fate is no different from their fierce, feline and equally-famous cousin – the African lion. EW
